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Who can participate in DuoEmploi?

Any individual:

- Aged 16 years or older.
- Interested and available to participate in a one-day exploratory internship.
- Identifying as having a disability as defined by the law: *A physical or mental impairment which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on your ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities.*



DuoEmploi is a one-day exploratory internship program taking place between June 1st and 7th, 2024. The internship will permit you to:

- Explore a career path or an industry.
- Prepare for competitive employment.
- Promote your professional skills.

Any individual interested in DuoEmploi 2024 is encouraged to learn more about how to successfully complete a DuoEmploi exploratory internship.

Useful tips for conducting your DuoEmploi exploratory internship

In preparation for the internship:

- 1 Ensure to have correctly identified goals for the DuoEmploi exploratory internship.
- 2 Prepare for the exploratory internship day by enlisting assistance from service providers and/or support workers.
- 3 Inquire about the internship schedule and demonstrate a professional attitude.
- 4 Prepare a CV.

After the internship:

- 1 Maintain or adjust career plans based on the results of the DuoEmploi internship.
- 2 Remain in contact with the company, especially if the intern's profile corresponds to their hiring needs.
- 3 Develop a new network of useful contacts for the purpose of job searching.

During the internship:

- 1 Dress appropriately for the internship.
- 2 Demonstrate interest and motivation and try to engage in conversation.
- 3 Show an interest in the business or company by asking pertinent questions.
- 4 Complete the end-of-day report in collaboration with the mentor and share thoughts and observations.

The mentor:

- 1 will welcome and accompany the intern throughout the day.
- 2 will provide a tour of the company as well as provide guidance, motivation, emotional support, and role modeling for the internship position.
- 3 will review the day's achievements and debrief on the overall experience.
